

1 everyday like the Vet recommended. She knew better. The two dogs that were being
2 "treated" (with vinegar dips or only an occasional dosage of ivermectin) for mange while
3 I was there never grew back any hair. Nor did they EVER go outside or leave their
4 crates.

5 7. On countless Saturdays I watched Ms. Peck discriminate against potential
6 adopters based on their ethnicity and their socioeconomic status. Additionally, I watched
7 Ms. Peck lie to people's faces about healthy animals that "weren't available for adoption".
8 I witnessed her lie to people and tell them she would be there that evening to do a
9 required home-check and deliver the dog to them. She would never show up. Many
10 people eventually got frustrated and stopped attempting to adopt a dog.

11 8. That summer, I returned endless number of telephone messages to potential
12 adoptive owners left on the "hotline" having to explain to people why Ms. Peck didn't
13 show up to deliver a dog she had promised. I dealt with their confusion, anger, and
14 sadness brought on as a direct result of Ms. Peck's lies.

15 9. Almost every time I visited the kennel I found rat/mouse feces in the
16 kitchen area and Ms. Peck's former desk area. There was often rotten human food on the
17 counter areas. Although she has denied it to authorities, I know that Ms. Peck lives in the
18 "office" area, sleeping on a sofa there every night.

19 10. I would describe the conditions as inhumane. There were so many animals
20 whose feet never touched the ground. Their lives were in a crate. This was not short
21 term. There were MANY animals that had been there for years, usually because Ms.
22 Peck claimed they had a variety of "chronic" medical conditions (that often changed with
23 each excuse) who never received medication or a visit to a Vet.

24 11. I saw dogs on a regular basis with feces in their water. I saw dogs without
25 any water or food. I saw dogs whose matted hair was full of feces. I saw dogs sitting in
26 their own urine and feces day after day.

27 12. I witnessed Ms Peck's vicious behavior directed toward her Veterinarians
28 (often described as killers if an animal died in their care), her staff and her volunteers,
and applicants seeking to adopt. She always had a new enemy in

the rescue world that was harassing her. Someone was always out to get her and harm her dogs.

13. I witnessed overflowing garbage cans full of feces and food in areas where the bigger dogs lived, many of which had no shelter from the sun or rain. These animals in the back were never taken on walks, never given medication, or any human attention the entire time I was a volunteer there.

14. I saw MANY animals whose quality of life was absolute zero that Ms. Peck refused to humanely euthanize. One for instance spent his day going in circles due to a serious brain damage condition. He never left his cage and I often found him lying in his own feces and urine. He was never cuddled or given any attention whatsoever.

15. I pleaded with Ms Peck to adopt the healthy animals to some of the many qualified homes that we had access to, only to be met with ridiculous excuses. No one other than Ms Peck was "qualified" to do a home check and therefore if she did not do it the animals just sat there. Week after week the same animals went out for adoptions and week after week qualified people came to adopt them. Most of these animals are still there.
